Course Description: 4.2 km (2.6 mile) circuit of rolling hills and wide turns. The course is in the shape of a bone – one long straight road with a loop at each end. The course will be closed to traffic and finishes on a slight uphill. Wheel pit will be along the straight road and accessible from both directions. Wheels in/wheels out.

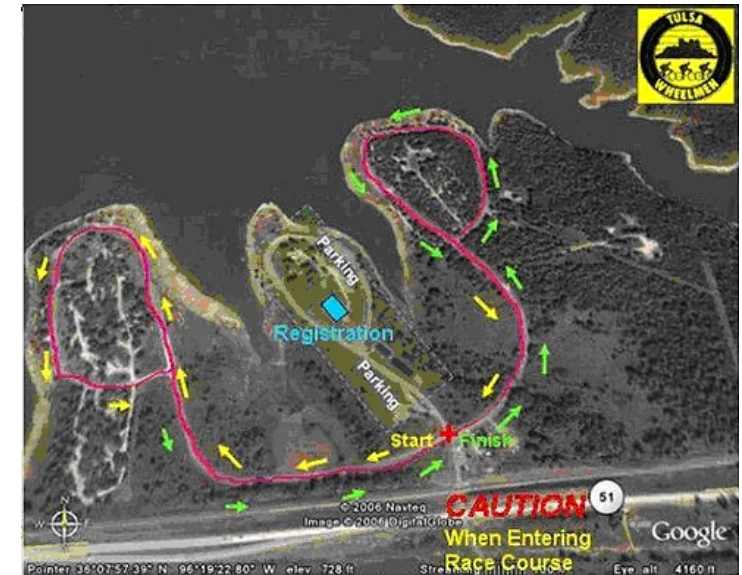

Directions:

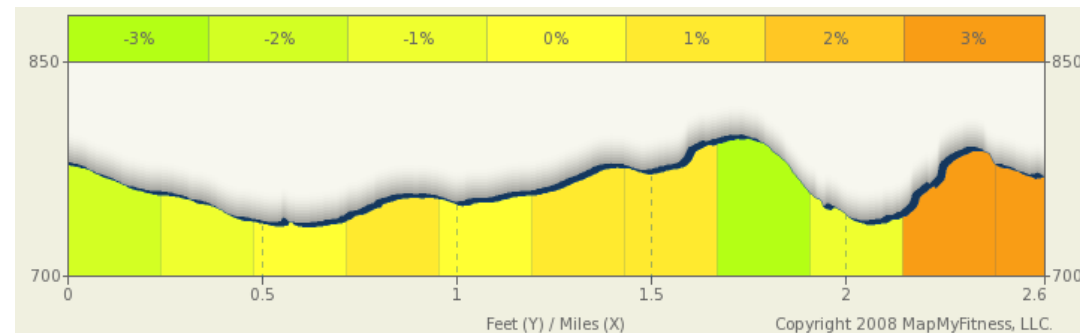
From Tulsa: Go west on Hwy 51. Just before the city of Mannford on the north side of the road will be the entrance to Salt Creek North.

From OKC: Go east on I-44. Exit at highway 48 and go north to the intersection of highway 51. Turn east onto highway 51 and go through the stoplight in Mannford. Just past the bridge you will see the entrance to Salt Creek on the north side of the highway.

Note: Numbers will be on right side of jersey. Women Open & Juniors will share the course, but will NOT be racing together. **ONLINE REGISTRATION ONLY!**

Course Description: A beautiful 20.5 mile course with demanding hills and challenging turns. Roads are open to traffic; "yellow line" rule will be enforced except for run-in to finish. Absolutely no trash on the course and no parking on roadways! Parking will be below the Skiatook Dam straight through along the way on left side of the dirt road. There will be three demanding hills climbing over 125ft in elevation back to back, but less than mile in length. Flat and fast sections, Finish will be different this year. More information will be available at start of the race on Sunday.

Directions: Go North from Downtown Tulsa, exit to Skiatook on HWY 20. Go through the town of Skiatook and Turn left on Lake Rd. You will take another left to park below the dam. **Use extreme caution as racers will be on the road.**

Notes: Numbers on right side of jersey. Save your number from Saturday. Results will posted 45 minutes after each race. Drafting behind passing group will not be allowed. No license renewal paperwork will be available at the race, please take care of this before race day.
